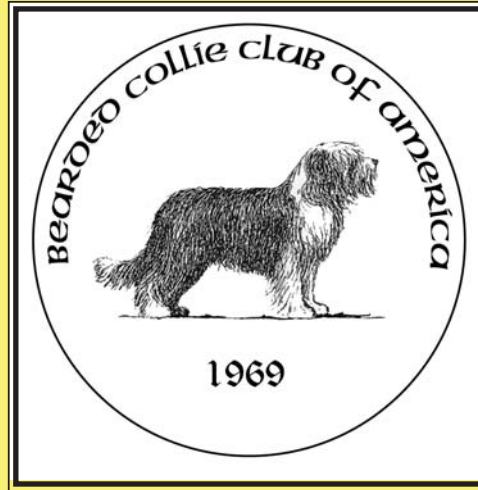

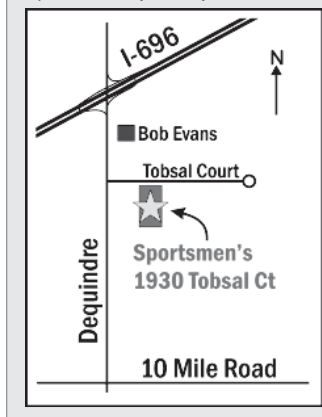

### PRIZE MONEY FOR SWEEPSTAKES

35% of all entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses; the remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

18% will go to Best in Sweepstakes and 12% to Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes, then

1st. Place in Each Class ..... 25% of the entry fees in that class      3rd. Place in Each Class ..... 15% of the entry fees in that class  
 2nd. Place in Each Class .... 20% of the entry fees in that class      4th. Place in Each Class ..... 10% of the entry fees in that class

This division of prize monies will apply to both Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes. **Entry fee is \$22.**

### PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all purebred Bearded Collies who are 6 months and under 20 months of age on the day of the show. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class at the regular entry fee. Indicate 'Sweepstakes' as an additional class in the space provided for 'Additional Classes', and check the appropriate age division. Dogs entered in Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club. AKC Champions of Record are not eligible. All prize money not awarded will be retained by the club. **CLASSES** (for dogs and bitches)

- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months
- 12 months and under 16 months
- 16 months and under 20 months

### VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Bearded Collies who are seven (7) years of age or older on the day of the sweepstakes. There is NO requirement that dogs be entered in any other class at this show. Dogs and bitches entered in Veteran Sweepstakes may be neutered or spayed. Veteran Sweepstakes will take place immediately after Puppy Sweepstakes and before regular judging.

**CLASSES** (for dogs and bitches)

- Veteran over 7 years, under 10 yrs.
- Veteran over 10 years, under 12 yrs.
- Veteran over 12 years, under 14 yrs.
- Veteran over 14 years of age

## BREED JUDGING - JUDGE: Miss Lesley Tomlinson

- BEST OF BREED

**NOTE: Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility** (AKC revision 9-02)

1. Dogs entered in Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC, as of the closing date for the show.
2. The person handling the dog must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog
3. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES - SINGLE DOG ENTRIES** **Entry Fee: \$22.00**

**Veteran Classes** - for Dogs and Bitches seven (7) years and older on the day of the show.

The first place winner in each Veteran Class will compete for Best of Breed.

**NOTE:** AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Section 8. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.

**Altered Classes** - for Altered Dogs and Bitches 5 months of age and older that have been neutered or spayed. Winners of these classes are NOT eligible for competition beyond Best Altered.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES - MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES** **Entry Fee: \$22.00**

**Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and TWO of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog class and shown in the ring with his Get. The Stud Dog may also be entered separately in one of the Regular Classes at the regular **entry fee of \$28**, with 'Stud Dog' class indicated on the entry form as an additional entry, at \$22. additional fee.

The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes, but there is no additional entry fee for them as participants with their sire in this non-regular class. The Get only will be judged, on the merit of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or being excused under the Dog Show rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

**Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog, Produce for Get.

**NOTE:** AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Section 8. A castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

**Maturity Class** - THREE GENERATIONS, male &/or female, not necessarily owned by one person or of identical ownership.

Three generations are shown oldest to youngest. Entry is limited to one dog from each generation. All generations to be entered as a single unit as 'Maturity' class on the entry form of one of the three that is entered in a regular class. All entrants making up the unit must be identified at the time of entry (attach a separate sheet to the entry form if necessary). The entry fee for the unit is \$22. Please note that the 'Generation' must be a grandparent, parent, pup. Any other combination such as a grandparent and two pups is unacceptable.

**~ RECENT CHANGES TO AKC RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS ~**  
*Some may affect your entry decisions for this specialty.*

*Eff. 1-1-10* Bred-By-Exhibitor entrants must be registered by the date of the event.  
*Eff. 1-1-10* AKC litter number will no longer be accepted on an entry form. All dogs must be individually registered by the day of the event to be eligible to exhibit at an AKC event. Only dogs that are individually registered with AKC or with a foreign registry organization and whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and whose registration with AKC has been delayed will with the AKC will be eligible for extension.

*Eff. 5-12-10* [Effective with the new 2010 Point Schedule] Grand Championship competition will begin for a NEW AKC TITLE OF GRAND CHAMPION (GCH). Competition will be judged concurrently with Best of Breed competition at both all-breed and specialty shows.

*'For many owners there is little incentive to continue to exhibit dogs that have completed their championship title. All exhibitors do not have the financial means or desire to extensively campaign a dog in pursuit of top rankings. This title permits quality dogs to be recognized without extensive travel as the Grand Champion title can be earned at all shows with Best of Breed competition.'*

**Who is Eligible for Grand Champion competition?**

The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition:

- Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class.
- Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. (The showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records.)
- Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.)

*Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition.*

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to:

Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition and in breeds that are divided into varieties, Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Variety competition.

**What are the requirements to earn the Grand Champion Title?**

- 25 Grand Champion points.
- A minimum of 9 points won at 3 shows with ratings of 3 or more points (Major wins) under three different judges, and one or more of the balance of points won under a 4th judge.
- At least one Champion of Record was defeated at three of these shows.

**How are Grand Champion points computed?**

- Grand Champion points are only to be awarded to dogs the judge considers deserving.
- Grand Champions points awarded to the Best of Breed/Variety shall count all dogs of both sexes competing in the regular classes and in Best of Breed/Variety competition.
- Grand Champion points awarded to Best of Opposite Sex shall count all dogs of their sex competing in the regular classes and in Best of Breed/Variety competition.
- Grand Champion points awarded to Select Dog/Bitch shall count all dogs of their sex defeated in the Best of Breed/Variety competition as well as the dogs of their sex in the regular classes.

*The entry of non-regular classes are not counted for computation of Grand Champion points to be awarded.*

**AKC will be sending email to the owners of all dogs that have finished since 1/1/2007 to inform them of this new opportunity to showcase their dogs.**
